10 DIFFERENT SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY PROVIDE TO THE HIRING SCHOOL  
11 DISTRICT EVIDENCE OF HIS OR HER STUDENT ACADEMIC GROWTH DATA  
12 AND PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS FOR THE PRIOR TWO YEARS FOR THE  
13 PURPOSES OF RETAINING NONPROBATIONARY STATUS. IF, UPON PROVIDING  
14 SUCH DATA, THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER CAN SHOW TWO  
15 CONSECUTIVE PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS WITH EFFECTIVENESS RATINGS

7 EXPERIENCES THAT SUPPORT THE INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL OF HIS OR HER  
8 SCHOOL, AND ARE ALIGNED TO THE SCHOOL'S CULTURE AND MISSION.  
9 THEREFORE, EACH EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT EXECUTED PURSUANT TO THIS  
10 SECTION SHALL CONTAIN A PROVISION STATING THAT A TEACHER MAY BE  
11 ASSIGNED TO A PARTICULAR SCHOOL ONLY WITH THE CONSENT OF THE  
12 HIRING PRINCIPAL AND WITH INPUT FROM AT LEAST TWO PRACTICING  
13 TEACHERS, AND AFTER A REVIEW OF THE TEACHER'S DEMONSTRATED  
14 EFFECTIVENESS, UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS AND POTENTIAL CONTRIBUTIONS  
15 TO THE SCHOOL'S EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS, SUCCESSFUL YEARS OF  
16 TEACHING EXPERIENCE, AND FIT WITH THE SCHOOL'S CULTURE AND  
17 MISSION.

18 (II) (A) ANY ACTIVE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER WHO, DURING  
19 THE PRIOR SCHOOL YEAR, WAS DEEMED SATISFACTORY, OR WAS DEEMED  
20 EFFECTIVE IN A DISTRICT THAT HAS IMPLEMENTED A MULTI-TIERED  
21 EVALUATION SYSTEM AND HAS IDENTIFIED RATINGS EQUIVALENT TO  
22 EFFECTIVE, AND HAS NOT SECURED A MUTUAL CONSENT PLACEMENT  
23 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF A PRIORITY HIRING POOL, WHICH PRIORITY HIRING

1 POOL SHALL ENSURE THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER A FIRST  
2 OPPORTUNITY TO INTERVIEW FOR AVAILABLE POSITIONS FOR WHICH HE OR  
3 SHE IS QUALIFIED IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT.

4 (B) WHEN A DETERMINATION IS MADE THAT A NONPROBATIONARY  
5 TEACHER'S SERVICES ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR THE REASONS SET  
6 FORTH IN SUBPARAGRAPH (VII) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (c.5), THE  
7 NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF HIS OR HER REMOVAL  
8 FROM THE SCHOOL. IN MAKING DECISIONS PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH  
9 (c.5), A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL CONSIDER PROBATIONARY AND  
10 NONPROBATIONARY STATUS AND THE NUMBER OF YEARS A TEACHER HAS  
11 BEEN TEACHING IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT; EXCEPT THAT THESE CRITERIA  
12 MAY BE CONSIDERED ONLY AFTER THE CONSIDERATION OF THE CRITERIA  
13 OF EFFECTIVENESS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 22-9-106. UPON NOTICE TO THE  
14 NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER, THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES  
15 FOR THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL IMMEDIATELY PROVIDE THE  
16 NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER WITH A LIST OF ALL VACANT POSITIONS FOR  
17 WHICH HE OR SHE IS QUALIFIED, AS WELL AS A LIST OF VACANCIES IN ANY  
18 AREA IDENTIFIED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO BE AN AREA OF CRITICAL  
19 NEED. AN APPLICATION FOR A VACANCY SHALL BE MADE TO THE  
20 PRINCIPAL OF A LISTED SCHOOL, WITH A COPY OF THE APPLICATION  
21 PROVIDED BY THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.  
22 THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER SHALL BE INTERVIEWED BY THE  
23 PRINCIPAL UNLESS THE POSITION IS FILLED BEFORE AN INTERVIEW OCCURS.  
24 WHEN A PRINCIPAL RECOMMENDS APPOINTMENT OF A NONPROBATIONARY  
25 TEACHER APPLICANT TO A VACANT POSITION, THE NONPROBATIONARY  
26 TEACHER SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THAT POSITION.

27 (C) THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE AT SUCH  
28 TIME AS THE PERFORMANCE EVALUATION SYSTEM BASED ON QUALITY  
29 STANDARDS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND THE RULES  
30 PROMULGATED BY THE STATE BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-9-105.5  
31 HAS COMPLETED THE INITIAL PHASE OF IMPLEMENTATION AND HAS BEEN  
32 IMPLEMENTED STATEWIDE. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE  
33 OF SUCH IMPLEMENTATION TO THE REVISOR OF STATUTES ON OR BEFORE  
34 JULY 1, 2014, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER UNTIL STATEWIDE  
35 IMPLEMENTATION OCCURS.

36 (III) (A) ANY ACTIVE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER WHO WAS  
37 DEEMED EFFECTIVE DURING THE PRIOR SCHOOL YEAR AND HAS NOT  
38 SECURED A MUTUAL CONSENT PLACEMENT SHALL BE A MEMBER OF A



1 PRIORITY HIRING POOL, WHICH PRIORITY HIRING POOL SHALL ENSURE THE  
2 NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER A FIRST OPPORTUNITY TO INTERVIEW FOR  
3 AVAILABLE POSITIONS FOR WHICH HE OR SHE IS QUALIFIED IN THE SCHOOL  
4 DISTRICT.

5 (B) WHEN A DETERMINATION IS MADE THAT A NONPROBATIONARY  
6 TEACHER'S SERVICES ARE NO LONGER REQUIRED FOR THE REASONS SET  
7 FORTH IN SUBPARAGRAPH (VII) OF THIS PARAGRAPH (c.5), THE  
8 NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF HIS OR HER  
9 REMOVAL. IN MAKING DECISIONS PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH (c.5), A  
10 SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL CONSIDER PROBATIONARY AND  
11 NONPROBATIONARY STATUS AND THE NUMBER OF YEARS A TEACHER HAS  
12 BEEN TEACHING IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT; EXCEPT THAT THESE CRITERIA  
13 MAY BE CONSIDERED ONLY AFTER THE CONSIDERATION OF THE CRITERIA  
14 OF EFFECTIVENESS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 22-9-106. UPON NOTICE TO  
15 THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL  
16 IMMEDIATELY PROVIDE THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER WITH A LIST OF  
17 ALL VACANT POSITIONS FOR WHICH HE OR SHE IS QUALIFIED, AS WELL AS  
18 A LIST OF VACANCIES IN ANY AREA IDENTIFIED BY THE SCHOOL DISTRICT  
19 TO BE AN AREA OF CRITICAL NEED. AN APPLICATION FOR A VACANCY  
20 SHALL BE MADE TO THE PRINCIPAL OF A LISTED SCHOOL, WITH A COPY OF  
21 THE APPLICATION PROVIDED BY THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER TO THE  
22 SCHOOL DISTRICT. THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER SHALL BE  
23 INTERVIEWED BY THE PRINCIPAL UNLESS THE POSITION IS FILLED BEFORE  
24 AN INTERVIEW OCCURS. WHEN A PRINCIPAL RECOMMENDS APPOINTMENT  
25 OF A NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER APPLICANT TO A VACANT POSITION,  
26 THE NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO THAT  
27 POSITION.

28 (C) THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (III) SHALL TAKE EFFECT AT SUCH TIME  
29 AS THE PERFORMANCE EVALUATION SYSTEM BASED ON QUALITY  
30 STANDARDS ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION AND THE RULES  
31 PROMULGATED BY THE STATE BOARD PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-9-105.5  
32 HAS COMPLETED THE INITIAL PHASE OF IMPLEMENTATION AND HAS BEEN  
33 IMPLEMENTED STATEWIDE. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE  
34 OF SUCH IMPLEMENTATION TO THE REVISOR OF STATUTES ON OR BEFORE  
35 JULY 1, 2014, AND EACH JULY 1 THEREAFTER UNTIL STATEWIDE  
36 IMPLEMENTATION OCCURS.

37 (IV) IF A NONPROBATIONARY TEACHER IS UNABLE TO SECURE A  
38 MUTUAL CONSENT ASSIGNMENT AT A SCHOOL OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT



1 AFTER TWO HIRING CYCLES, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL PLACE THE  
2 TEACHER ON UNPAID LEAVE UNTIL SUCH TIME AS THE TEACHER IS ABLE TO  
3 SECURE AN ASSIGNMENT. IF THE TEACHER SECURES AN ASSIGNMENT AT  
4 A SCHOOL OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WHILE PLACED ON UNPAID LEAVE, THE  
5 SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL REINSTATE THE TEACHER'S SALARY AND BENEFITS  
6 AT THE LEVEL THEY WOULD HAVE BEEN IF THE TEACHER HAD NOT BEEN  
7 PLACED ON UNPAID LEAVE.

8 (V) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL LIMIT THE ABILITY OF A  
9 SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PLACE A TEACHER IN A TWELVE-MONTH OR OTHER  
10 LIMITED-TERM ASSIGNMENTS, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A  
11 TEACHING ASSIGNMENT, SUBSTITUTE ASSIGNMENT, OR INSTRUCTIONAL  
12 SUPPORT ROLE DURING THE PERIOD IN WHICH THE TEACHER IS ATTEMPTING  
13 TO SECURE A MUTUAL CONSENT ASSIGNMENT. SUCH AN ASSIGNMENT  
14 SHALL NOT CONSTITUTE A MUTUAL CONSENT ASSIGNMENT AND SHALL NOT  
15 BE DEEMED TO INTERRUPT THE PERIOD IN WHICH THE TEACHER IS  
16 REQUIRED TO SECURE A MUTUAL CONSENT ASSIGNMENT BEFORE THE  
17 DISTRICT SHALL PLACE THE TEACHER ON UNPAID LEAVE.

18 (VI) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH (c.5) MAY BE WAIVED  
19 IN WHOLE OR IN PART FOR A RENEWABLE FOUR-YEAR PERIOD BY THE  
20 STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-2-117, PROVIDED  
21 THAT THE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARD APPLYING FOR THE WAIVER, IN  
22 CONJUNCTION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT AND TEACHERS ASSOCIATION,  
23 IF APPLICABLE, DEMONSTRATES THAT THE WAIVER IS IN THE BEST  
24 INTEREST OF STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, SUPPORTS  
25 THE EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION OF EFFECTIVE TEACHERS, AND WILL NOT  
26 RESULT IN PLACEMENT OTHER THAN BY MUTUAL CONSENT OF THE  
27 TEACHER IN A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL THAT IS REQUIRED TO  
28 IMPLEMENT A PRIORITY IMPROVEMENT PLAN OR TURNAROUND PLAN  
29 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 11 OF THIS TITLE. NOTWITHSTANDING THE  
30 PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH (c.5), A WAIVER SHALL NOT BE GRANTED  
31 FOR A REQUEST THAT EXTENDS THE TIME FOR SECURING A MUTUAL  
32 CONSENT ASSIGNMENT FOR MORE THAN TWO YEARS.

33 (VII) THIS PARAGRAPH (c.5) SHALL APPLY AS A RESULT OF SCHOOL  
34 CLOSURE, CONSOLIDATION, RECONSTITUTION, DROP IN ENROLLMENT,  
35 REDUCTION IN BUILDING, PHASE OUT, OR REDUCTION IN PROGRAM."
